Notes for Teachers: Diaries Year 6 term 1 objective 14 Autobiographical writing

NB this also relates to objective 11: autobiography and the difference between fact and opinion.

## Aims

To develop skills of autobiographical writing in role, adopting the distinctive voice of a historical character.

#### Resources

- Kids' Castle website: <u>http://www.kidsonthenet.com/castle</u>. Click on Lucy's Tower. Also explore the rest of Kids' Castle to get more information on life in castle times.
- A downloadable activity sheet (Word).

### Introduction

This is based on a tower in Kids' Castle. Lady Sherwood's niece, Lucy, keeps a diary of her life in the castle. There is information regarding one of the real historical characters on which a diary entry may be based. There is a <u>downloadable activity sheet</u> (Word).

### Activities and points for discussion

- Have any of the children visited a castle?
- Explore the Kids' Castle website, to get a feel for the other types of characters available
- Read other diary entries on the website sent in by children from other schools.
- Discuss:
- the difference between biography and autobiography
- writing in the first person
- distinguishing between fact and opinion
- composing a biographical account based on research
- Use the <u>downloadable activity sheet.</u> http://www.kidsonthenet.com/teachers/downloads/Y6t1obj14diaries\_as.doc
- Research some of the vocabulary on the sheet for authentic detail.
- Children can submit a diary entry entitled, 'Imagine a day living in a castle', using the web form. Go to <u>http://www.kidsonthenet.com/castle</u> and in Lucy's Tower click on the shield with quill and brush.
